Are you interested in creativity, innovation and would like to learn more about legal tools to protect creative ideas? If so, join CopyrightX! CopyrightX is a 12 week online course during which students will learn about the key concepts of American copyright law (authorship, creativity, fair use). CopyrightX is offered jointly by Harvard Law School and Kyushu University.

Students of CopyrightX will have weekly classes during which participants will engage in fun discussions based on real-world cases. Learning materials comprise video lectures and assigned readings (on average, approximately 3 hours/week). More information available at: copyx.org

At the end of the course, students who successfully pass the test will be eligible to get a Certificate issued by Harvard Law School.
