Centering on the concept of “**Borderland**” and the themes of **Migration, Mobilities and Immobilities** that have emerged as among the most pressing 21st century challenges, that cut across 11 of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals, this UC-Berkeley - University of Copenhagen course, in collaboration with Chiang Mai University, engages students from multiple disciplines in thinking critically about the research process, epistemologies, and ethics in conducting research.

Students will interact with international and local scholars in structured seminars, and with communities and organizations working to address pressing local, regional and global issues through their placement with local NGOs and research projects.
